## Key Strategies for Neat Printing

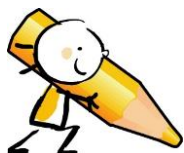


My strategies for neat printing:



- Slow down
- Print letters from top to bottom
- Print letters on the line (no floaters)
- Print tall letters tall (b, d, f, h, k, l, t)
- Print small letters small (a, c, e, i, m, n, o, r, s, u, v, w, x, z)
- Print "digger" letters digging down below baseline (g, j, p, q, y)
- Leave a finger space between words
- Use correct capitalization and punctuation
