ALPHABET CUE CARD – LABELLED LINES

Top Line: Tall letters start at the top line



Dotted Interline: Small letters start at or just below the dotted interline

Baseline: All letters sit on the baseline

Digger letters dig below the baseline to the next interline or line

ALPHABET CUE CARD – LINES for MODELLING



Key Strategies for Neat Printing - Capitals



My strategies for neat printing of Capital Letters:

- Slow down
- Print letters from top to bottom
- Print letters on the line (no floaters)
- Print all capitals “tall” (not small)
